

Note on some organizational developments

1. As per the decision of the Working Committee, EEFI President, General Secretary and Senior leader Com. S DevRoye and Subhash Lamba met the General Secretaries of CITU Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar and Gujarat during the General Council meeting of CITU. The states will try to establish primary contacts and organize meetings with EEFI Centre leadership by the month of August 2025. This will be followed up by Com. Sudip Dutta and Com. Subhash Lamba.
2. DVC Shramik Union successfully organized their conference on 11-12 May 2025 at Bankura, West Bengal. The conference was attended by EEFI GS.
3. MSU Punjab Conference was held on 24-25 May 2025; the conference was well attended. Due to the General Council of CITU, no EEFI Centre leadership could attend the conference.
4. The conference of AP UEEU will be held on 14-15th June 2025 at Guntur, AP. Comrade S. Rajendran will attend the conference from EEFI Centre.
5. COTEE Conference will be held on 8-10 August 2025 at Cuddalore, Tamil Nadu.
6. The conference of KSEB OA will be held on 22-24 August 2025 at Kerala.
7. Long struggle was going on in NTPL Power plant of Tuticorin, Tamil Nadu. 1,500 contract workers were in strike for 29 days for achieving the NLC agreed minimum wage. After long struggle they called-off the strike with a Rs. 90 per day wage hike.
8. Consistent struggle is going on in Himachal Pradesh where Electricity Employees, Pensioners and Consumers are mobilizing thousands of people in every district. Undoubtedly the mobilization strength is spectacular.
9. UP struggle is going on for last 185 days. The Govt. is desperate to bulldoze all protests and the UP Power Corporation has notified a draconian order empowering the Management to unilaterally remove or demote any employee. In protest, we organized lunch-hour demonstration all across the country under the banner of NCCOEEE. But the initiative was not enough. Any day the Management can float the tender notice. It is very important to campaign about this anti-democratic attitude of the BJP Govt. and prepare for any nation-wide militant action on this issue.
10. We have made some connections across the production chain of nuclear power generation. We have units and connections in Nuclear Power Corporation of India Ltd. (NPCIL) in Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra. We have connection in Nuclear Fuel Complex (NFC) in Hyderabad and union in Heavy water plant in Manguru, Telangana. In the month of July, we are planning to organize a leadership meeting of Nuclear Power and ancillary units in Delhi. This will be a new area of expansion for us.
11. A Thermal Power Generation unit of Jharkhand will affiliate to EEFI. We have already started the procedures in this regard.
